4. Ethical Partnerships

We safeguard the personal information of everyone who interacts with Bahali. We do not sell, trade, or misuse personal data. Our privacy practices reflect our commitment to dignity and respect.

6. Program Integrity

All Bahali resources—including coping guides, toolkits, workshops, and training materials—are developed with evidence-informed practices, cultural relevance, and the needs of Caribbean families in mind. We are transparent about what our tools are—and what they are not. They supplement, but do not replace, mental health or medical treatment.

7. Community-Centered Feedback

We welcome questions, suggestions, and feedback from the individuals and communities we serve. Listening to those with lived experience helps us strengthen our programs and remain accountable to our mission.
